





North-East Monsoon 2023/2024

According to data released by the Malaysian Meteorological Department (MET Malaysia), the Northeast Monsoon (MTL) is expected to occur from November 2023 to March 2024. MET Malaysia predicts that during this period, four to six episodes of heavy rain will occur.

Heavy rain occurred in Kelantan, Terengganu, Pahang, Johor, and some Borneo areas during the initial phase of MTL, which continued from November 2023 to January 2024. As a result, water levels in low-lying areas have increased over usual levels, resulting in flooding events and affecting the people who live there.





At the end of 2023, National Disaster Management Agency (NADMA) reported, a total of 28,032 people have been affected by floods since November 2023, and 137 PPS have been set up in five states: Kelantan, Terengganu, Pahang, Johor, and Sabah. Until the mid of January 2024, it is reported that there are still areas that are still flooded causing the number of flood victims to increase.

Flood Emergency Aid Response







To alleviate the burden on affected flood victims, MyFundAction and Bursa Malaysia teamed to launch the Flood Disaster Emergency Assistance Mission, which focuses on three (3) relief; 1) Emergency Meal Ready To Eat (MRE), 2) Post-Flood Basic Food Basket and 3) Emotional Management for Children.



Emergency Meal Ready To Eat Set (MRE)

A practical food pack set (lunch and dinner) to eat when facing a situation like a flood. Completed with nutrients, this meal ready to eat pack (MRE) is ready to be eaten hot by only using water at anytime, anywhere.



Post-Flood Basic Food Basket (Rezeki Ummat)

This post-flood food basket can assist relieve the burden on affected flood victims by giving basic food that is difficult for them to find after the flooding receded.




Emotional Management (My Fun Kit)

Impacts



Nutrient benefit during disaster

Food is a basic human requirement, especially after a disaster when physical exertion might caloric raise requirements. Food shortages are possible during a flood. By giving food support such as Meal Ready to Eat (MRE), they are able to eat something with good nutritional value and ease of preparation.

Reduced financial burden

Floods ruined homes, cars, and other goods, including food supplies. After the flood, it is difficult to obtain food around them. Addressing the flood-related loss, our goal is to ease the financial burden of flood victims by providing immediate help following the calamity.

Psychological support

Flood victims may have long-term psychological impacts, including distress, anxiety, pain, social sadness, and dysfunctions. Through psychological support activity with our volunteer, they are able to develop inner drive and relieve their worry about the challenge that they have went through.



Improving Relief Governance

Collaboration between **NGOs** and the government can create efficient coordination of allocation and resources, indicating excellent governance. NGOs serve as catalysts and mediators, boosting communication and collective speeding actions to strengthen community support for government authorities during disasters.

Humanitarian Volunteering Platform

Emergency flood relief can foster a sense of community solidarity by bringing people together to help one another. Volunteers have the potential to have a direct and positive impact on of the lives those impacted, and their actions help to improve the overall effectiveness of relief operations.

Achieving SDG goals

SDG impacts on flood relief efforts, which address food insecurity by providing emergency food and support (SDG collaborative 2), and relationships among governments, NGOs, businesses, and local communities are crucial effective for flood disaster response (SDG 17).

CDA-ERT MyFundAction



CDA-ERT 08. MyFundAction is a registered relief team with the Malaysian Civil Defence Force (APM) that can provide assistance when disaster strikes Malaysia. CDA-ERT provides three (3) primary help scopes: training, expertise (health), and humanitarian services (food) to victims and personnel during disasters. CDA-ERT MyFundAction is also responsible for assisting in the early mitigation of the impact of an emergency or catastrophe by carrying out disaster preparedness training activities with the community (safety component) and channelling basic needs support.



Aid Delivery Procedure

Application for approval to deploy the CDA-ERT MyfundAction team to the area of the aid mission via the Selangor State APM

Notification and permission from the State PKOB / District PKOB at the mission location

Relief items were distributed directly to the victims by APM and JKM.

JKM will enter and validate the receipt of donations into the registry of JKM donation beneficiaries.
